PARTY AT YOUR PLACE?

DID YOU KNOW?

There's a social host gathering ordinance that could affect you.

THE DETAILS

An unruly social gathering is an event with 4 or more people at a residence or other private property where there is underage drinking or conduct that disturbs the peace.

Persons responsible can be the owner, occupant, tenant, landlord, or those who organize and supervise the gathering. If under age 18, a parent or legal guardian can be liable.

THE CONSEQUENCES

Police can write **civil citations** to hosts, renters, landlords, or property owners with **penalties of S500 and 20 hours of community service for a first violation**. Penalties increase to **S1,000 and 32 hours of community service for subsequent violations**.
